Thank you for your recent letter to President George W. Bush concerning the automated pay system for military personnel and the pay [REDACTED] (b)(3) 10 USC 130b. I want to assure you that we currently are conducting a 100% audit of [REDACTED] (b)(3) 10 USC 130b payroll account covering the period of June 2000 to June 2002. We will resolve [REDACTED] (b)(3) 10 USC 130b Army pay problems.

At this time, I cannot release [REDACTED] (b)(3) 10 USC 130b personal information, including payroll information, without his signed authorization. In adhering to the Privacy Act, we will communicate the detailed results of this audit directly [REDACTED] (b)(3) 10 USC 130b as soon as possible.

Your recommendation for changes to the Army finance computer equipment and programs is well founded. In an effort to improve both the military payroll and personnel systems, the Department of Defense has initiated a project to integrate both system's equipment and programs. The Defense Integrated Military Human Resource System is well on its way and will replace the current legacy systems that were developed back in the 1970's and 1980's. 
