
Dear Mr. President,

Dear Mr. President,

On Sunday, November 6, 1983, almost 18 years ago, our Marine Corps conducted a solemn memorial service at Washington National Cathedral to honor the 241 gallant peacekeepers who were murdered by state sponsored terrorists in Beirut, Lebanon, two weeks before. Until September 11, 2001, this had been the most massive terrorist attack against Americans in our history. In his biography, "An American Life," President Reagan referred to it as the lowest of the low points of his eight year presidency.

I was moved to tears, Mr. President, when I saw you sitting in the same seat in the National Cathedral last Friday as I had occupied during our service. I watched with pride as you walked with dignity and resolve to the pulpit and gave your fellow Americans and the world a truly moving message. In 1983, I walked that same walk to read the gospel I had chosen from John 10: 11-18, "The Good Shepherd."

The purpose of my letter, Mr. President, is twofold. First, to tell you that in a much smaller way I feel your pain...a unique form of pain that can only be felt by a leader, and our leader you truly are. And, second, to tell you that I stand ready if ever you need my services during these extraordinary times. *I mean this sincerely.*

In closing, let me proudly say that during my darkest days in 1983, another George Bush stood by and supported the 28th Commandant of the Marine Corps and his Marines. For that I shall be forever grateful.

Barbara joins me in sending our deepest respect and admiration to you and Laura, and may God bless our beloved America...the land of the free only so long as it remains the home of the brave!

Thank you all for having me participate in the service last Friday.


Your address was a masterpiece that touched all the bases at this critical time in our history.
