FOIA 2019-0115-F requested a letter from Lydia Sandri to President George W. Bush in 2008.

This FOIA primarily contains draft and final letters sent to the Sandri family regarding meeting President George W. Bush, a letter from Lydia Sandri to President George W. Bush, photocopies of photographs of the meeting, mailing labels, and other administrative documents related to the drafting of the letters and mailing of photographs. The Sandri family met with President George W. Bush in December 2008 after Sergeant Matthew Sandri, a 24 year old soldier, was killed in action in 2004.

**System of Arrangement**

The materials in FOIA 2019-0115-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.
