On May 5, 1862, an outnumbered band of Mexican soldiers dug into the hilltops above the city – and defeated a professional European army against overwhelming odds. The victory inspired Mexican patriots in their heroic fight for liberty and democracy. Cinco de Mayo is a joyful day in Mexican history – and it is an important milestone in the history of freedom.

The people of the United States are proud to celebrate Cinco de Mayo with our Mexican neighbors. Our two countries continue to stand for the principles that the Mexican Army defended at Puebla. We believe that democracy represents the true will of the people ... we believe that freedom is God's gift to every man, woman, and child ... and we believe that both our countries have a responsibility to share the blessings of liberty.
