JIMMY CARTER

October 29, 2001

To President George W. Bush

I understand that you are seeking the passage of fast-track legislation that will enhance our ability to negotiate freer trade agreements bilaterally, regionally, and under the auspices of the World Trade Organization. I have always believed that the United States greatly benefits from such trade agreements, and following the Tokyo round while I was president I have supported each effort by my successors to achieve this goal.

It is important that Congress approve trade-promotion authority as soon as possible, and my hope is that adequate bi-partisan support can be obtained to make this possible. I know from experience that there are a number of Democrats who have never been willing to approve any such legislation, but we have been able to depend on others who have taken a consistently positive approach. Like myself, they have insisted on reasonable labor and environmental standards among the nations that will become our new trade partners. These include Congressmen Charles Rangel, Sander Levin, Bob Matsui, and Jim McDermott, who, I understand, have not been involved in the drafting of the Thomas-Dooley bill.

I have heard that you will be meeting with some of these Democratic leaders, and trust that an accommodation can be reached with them so that the Thomas-Dooley bill can be strengthened and enjoy wider support among the democratic leaders. If so, please assure Ambassador Zoellick that I will be glad to help in any way possible. Such legislation offers the best chance of success in Congress and a firm foundation on which to lead the world toward a freer trading system.
