Dear Mr. President,

Ref: History repeating itself

Let on behalf of all the slow people worldwide; express my sincere happy belated birthday to you. Mr. President let me once again thank God Almighty for bringing you at this time of history to save our people.

May God Almighty continue to richly bless you and this Great Nation.
