Dear Mr. Mica:

Thank you for your letter of December 22, 2005 to the President requesting that he consider Mr. Ometrias Deon Long for inclusion in a White House delegation to Liberia for the January 16 inauguration of Liberian President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf. The White House has asked us to reply on its behalf. We regret the delay in responding.

As you are aware, First Lady Laura Bush led the White House delegation to Liberia, which the White House kept relatively small. We regret that Mr. Long as well as others who follow Liberia closely and are supportive of our efforts there could not be accommodated as delegation participants.

Thank you for your continuing interest in U.S.-Liberian relations, especially at this pivotal time, as President Sirleaf becomes the first elected female head of state in Africa. Our combined efforts are key to the consolidation of democracy in Liberia and to stability in the region.


I am writing to urge the appointment of Mr. Ometrias Deon Long as a member of the official United States Delegation attending the Inauguration of the President of Liberia on January 16.
