THE PRESIDENT HAS SEEN

- There is no greater symbol of our Nation's resolve than to mobilize the National Guard and Reserve. This affects the life of every American. You are our sons and daughters, our mothers and fathers, our coworkers, and neighbors.
- The strength of America has always been found in the courage and character of its citizens. And that is especially true of our citizen soldiers.
- Last week I proclaimed a National Emergency and authorized the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of Transportation to call up the Ready Reserve units of the Armed Forces and Coast Guard to active duty. We are in the process of calling up as many as thirty-five thousand reservists. They will serve in a number of essential roles, such as:
  - Helping maintain our air defenses on high alert
  - Checking shipping in ports
  - Helping our military with airlift and logistics
  - Providing military police
  - Participating in engineering projects
  - Helping gather intelligence
  - Performing work as chaplains.
- I know this call up means a real sacrifice for you and your families. But you understand better than most that freedom has a cost – which our generation is prepared to bear.
- I also want to thank your employers. They understand that the bottom line is more than just profit and loss. The bottom line is doing what it takes to win this war so Americans can be safe and secure.
- Winston Churchill once said that the “reservist is twice the citizen.” He was right. Today, America thanks you for your willingness to serve and sacrifice at this moment when our country needs you.
