### I. PURPOSE

To deliver remarks at the First Flight Centennial Celebration.

### II. BACKGROUND

**Note:** If good weather, the event will be outdoors, and there will be 35,000 attendees. In the event of inclement weather, the event will be moved indoors and there will be 600 seated attendees.

#### Orville and Wilbur Wright

The Wright brothers spent most of their inventive years in Dayton, Ohio. However, the climate and terrain of southern Ohio did not provide the necessary conditions to test their models, and in 1903, they selected Kitty Hawk, North Carolina, as the best location to successfully test their bi-plane model.

**Note:** The actual site of their first flight (where you will visit today) is now located in Kill Devil Hills.

The Wrights' successful test flight occurred at 10:35 a.m. on December 17, 1903, and lasted for 12 seconds traveling 120 feet.

#### North Carolina First Flight Centennial

The five-day First Flight Centennial Celebration will culminate today with a re-enactment of the Wright Brothers' flight exactly one hundred years after the first successful test. Each day of the celebration has a theme. The theme for today is "12 Seconds that Changed the World." You will not be present for the re-enactment.

#### Wright Brothers National Memorial

The Wright Brothers National Memorial is operated by the National Park Service. The Memorial Park contains the site where the Wright Brothers tested their first successful flight. The re-enactment will occur a few hundred feet away from the original test flight location. A 60-foot granite monument dedicated in 1932 commemorating the Wright brothers' achievement sits atop 90-foot tall Kill Devil Hill.

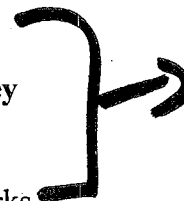

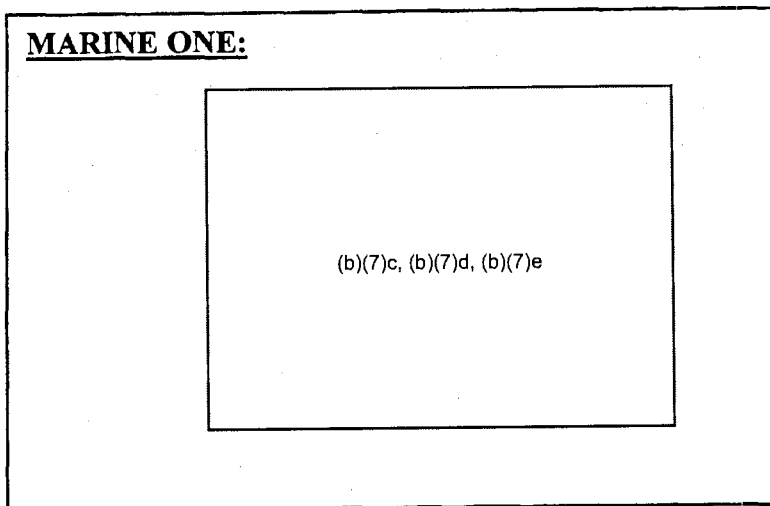
