Watch James' new movie! **Submerged** -- TV Movie (NBC) with Shea Whigham, Emily Procter and James B. Sikking. Directed by James Keach. Based on "The Terrible Hours" by Peter Maas. NBC: May 20, 2001 - A moment-by-moment account of the sinking and rescue of the American submarine USS Squalus months before World War II began.

Director JAMES KEACH has worked over the years as an actor, writer, producer and director. He directed the Warner Brothers feature film "The Stars Fell On Henrietta" in association with Malpaso Productions with Clint Eastwood producing. The critically acclaimed film stars Robert Duvall, Aide Quinn and Frances Fisher.

A graduate of Northwestern University and the Yale School of Drama, James Keach received classical training as an actor at the New York Shakespeare Festival under director Joseph Papp. He went on to perform on stage at the Body Politic Theater in Chicago, and directed theater in Chicago, New York and at the Los Angeles Mark Taper Forum. As an actor, Keach has starred in over fifty feature films including "Wildcats" with Goldie Hawn, "Love Letters" with Jamie Lee Curtis, "Vacation", "The Experts", "Moving Violations", "Comes A Horseman" and "The Razor's Edge" with Bill Murray.

Keach executive produced and co-wrote the feature films "The Long Riders" (in which he also starred as Jesse James) and "Armed and Dangerous". He produced the feature "The Experts" and co-wrote and directed the telefilm "The Forgotten" which received a Cable Ace Award. He also received two Western Heritage Awards for Best Director for the series "The Young Riders" (which he also produced). The television movie "A Winner Never Quits: The Pete Gray Story", produced by Keach, won the Humanitas Award for ABC. Keach also produced and directed "False Identity" for RKO, which starred Stacy Keach, Jr. and Genevieve Bujold.

He produced and directed his wife, Jane Seymour, in the telefilms "A Passion for Justice: The Hazel Brannon Smith Story", "Sunstroke", "Praying Mantis" and "The Absolute Truth" through their production company, Catfish Productions. Keach returned to acting in the feature film "The New Swiss Family Robinson" starring opposite his wife. The Catfish production of "A Marriage of Convenience," directed by James Keach and starring Jane Seymour, garnered the highest ratings of a CBS television movie last season.

BACKGROUND: 61*, an HBO docudrama about the amazing 1961 race
between Yankees Roger Maris and Mickey Mantle to
topple Babe Ruth's mythic 60-home run record.

When it was over, Maris had beaten Ruth's record by
hitting his 61st homer on the final day of the season.
Meanwhile, Mantle finished with 54 home runs after
missing several games at the end of the season because of
illness.

The movie's title also recalls the controversial asterisk
attached to Maris' record by baseball commissioner Ford
Frick. The American League had expanded its season to
162 games by 1961, up from the 154 games played in
Ruth's day.
