PURPOSE:

To address the annual National Right to Life Committee
Educational Trust Fund 'Proudly Pro-Life' dinner.

BACKGROUND:

The National Right to Life Committee was founded in 1973 in
response to a United States Supreme Court decision released on
January 22 of that year, legalizing the practice of human abortion in all
50 states, throughout the entire nine months of pregnancy. In June of
1973, a group of pro-life leaders met in Detroit for the first meeting of
a new organization, to be non-sectarian, non-partisan, and to have its
board consist of an elected representative from each of the 50 states.
These first board members included experts in the fields of science,
medicine, medical ethics, constitutional law, and religion.

Since its official beginning at that conference, the National Right to
Life Committee has grown to represent over 3000 chapters in all 50
states and the District of Columbia.
