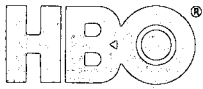

MAYOR RUDOLPH W. GIULIANI PROVIDES AN IN-DEPTH PERSONAL ACCOUNT OF

LOS ANGELES, Jan. 16, 2002 – Tuesday, September 11, 2001, started as just another day. At 8:47 a.m., the city that never sleeps would be jolted into its worst nightmare as a chain of tragic events unfolded, changing the life of New Yorkers and America forever. The Twin Towers of the World Trade Center would fall, and thousands would lose their lives. The flag would wave over a new battlefield called Ground Zero.

IN MEMORIAM: SEPTEMBER 11, 2001, NEW YORK CITY is a record of the events of that day. With the Honorable Rudolph W. Giuliani as guide, the documentary follows the mayor and his staff from their first realization of what had occurred, through smoke and fire, through rescue and recovery, through despair and tears, to a newfound strength that would emerge in the spirit of a new America.

The film draws on unprecedented access to City Hall and the Mayor's staff, as well as archival documents, combined with eyewitness accounts and news footage, including extensive, never-before-seen footage from independent and amateur filmmakers. IN MEMORIAM: SEPTEMBER 11, 2001, NEW YORK CITY, which presents a unique historical record of that fateful day in New York City, debuts Memorial Day weekend, SUNDAY, MAY 26 (10:00-11:00 p.m. ET), exclusively on HBO.

"People in the city now have this spiritual connection that they never had before, this great love of being a New Yorker, this tremendous pride of being a New Yorker," comments Mayor Giuliani. "And America

feels this tremendously, a connection to the city of New York. The city has never been stronger in its soul, never been a stronger place than it is now. But as we move further and further away from September 11, I think we're going to have to remember it in its reality."

The film will be donated to The Museum of the City of New York where it will live as an archival record of that historic day. All materials used in the making of the film, from transcripts to outtakes, will be archived at the Museum. Giuliani, Brad Grey Television and HBO/AOL Time Warner have all agreed to donate their production fees in connection with the project to the Twin Towers Fund, which was established by Mayor Giuliani.

The purpose of the Twin Towers Fund is to assist, support, and recognize the families of the members of the uniformed services of the New York City Fire Department and its Emergency Medical Service Command, the New York City Police Department, the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, the New York State Office of Court Administration, and other government offices who lost their lives or were injured because of the tragedies of September 11, 2001, at the World Trade Center in New York City.
