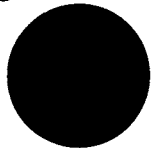

Dear Mr. President:

I am pleased to transmit to you the 2004 Annual Report of the Securities Investor Protection Corporation ("SIPC") as required by 15 U.S.C. § 78ggg.

SIPC protects securities customers of a SIPC member broker-dealer in the event of the firm's financial failure. In 2004, SIPC initiated two customer protection proceedings. These two proceedings, taken together, present only modest exposure to the SIPC fund. The SIPC fund contained approximately \$1.29 billion on December 31, 2004. Net of accrued liabilities of \$56.7 million, the SIPC Fund's net assets totaled \$1.23 billion.

The Commission will continue to oversee SIPC to assure that the SIPC program provides adequate protection for the nation's investors.
