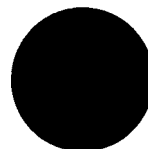

Dear Mr. President:

I am pleased to transmit to you the 2005 Annual Report of the Securities Investor Protection Corporation ("SIPC") as required by 15 U.S.C. § 78ggg.

SIPC restores funds to investors with assets held by bankrupt and otherwise financially troubled SIPC-member brokerage firms. In 2005, SIPC initiated one customer protection proceeding. This proceeding presents only a relatively modest exposure to the SIPC fund. The SIPC fund contained approximately \$1.29 billion on December 31, 2005. Net of accrued liabilities of \$37.4 million, the SIPC Fund's net assets totaled \$1.25 billion.

The Commission will continue to oversee SIPC to assure that the SIPC program provides adequate protection for the nation's investors.
