FOIA 2014-0243-F contains materials related to correspondence between President George W. Bush and William F. Buckley.

This FOIA primarily contains correspondence between President George W. Bush and William F. Buckley, an invitation to President George W. Bush for the 50th anniversary of National Review, along with thank you and condolence messages from President George W. Bush.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2014-0243-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files and Staff Member Office Files.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
