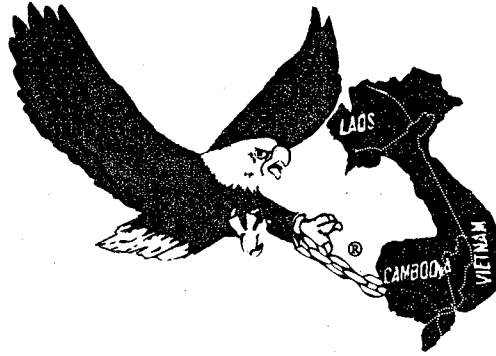

I request your personal attention to this idea. It is a televised White House patriotic event that I think will galvanize the veterans and healthcare communities, as well as the nation in your support. I saw a prototype of the proposed program last week on Capitol Hill, as I participated in the 9th Congressional Flag Day Concert by the Veterans-Medical Musical Group (VA-MMG). It is truly awesome and powerful.

Our idea is to tape this as a one hour "Concert for America" at the White House on or around Labor Day. It would be broadcast at the end of October as an early Veterans Day program, since Veterans Day comes later on November 11. The theme is "For the Love of America." 



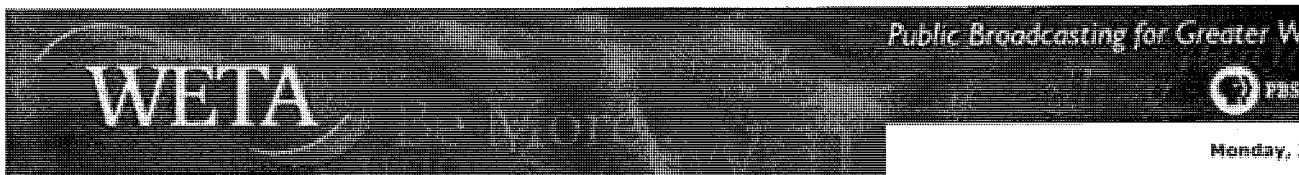

Sharon Percy Rockefeller
President and Chief Executive Officer

Sharon Percy Rockefeller has served the public broadcasting community for more than 25 years as a leader and policymaker. She has been president and CEO of WETA, Washington, D.C.'s flagship public television and radio stations since 1989. She continues to guide WETA to outstanding accomplishments in broadcasting and production. Before assuming the top post at WETA, she was a member of WETA's Board of Trustees for seven years and a member of the board of directors of the Corporation for Public Broadcasting for 12 years, including four years as chairman. In 2000, Rockefeller was elected to the PBS Board of Directors for her fourth term.



A graduate of Stanford University, Rockefeller is active in a number of areas including education, fine arts, government and women's issues. She serves on the boards of PepsiCo, Sotheby's, the Phillips Collection, The Museum of Modern Art, and the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation. She is a member of the Trustees Council of the National Gallery of Art and a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. Rockefeller is the former chairman of the Virginia Association of Public Television Stations. She is a trustee of the Federal City Council and a member and former chairman of the Stanford-in-Washington Council. She was formerly a member of the board of Stanford University, the University of Chicago, the Smithsonian Associates, the National Cathedral School, the George Washington University and the Smithsonian American Art Commission.

In October of 1994, Rockefeller was named a recipient of the Charles Frankel Prize by the National Endowment for the Humanities in recognition of her outstanding achievements in promoting the arts and humanities in her public broadcasting career. She has also received the Distinguished Broadcaster Award, and was named a Washingtonian of the Year by *Washingtonian* magazine. Most recently, Rockefeller was honored with the Women of Vision Award from Women in Film and Video and the CINE Lifetime Achievement Award.

In West Virginia she served for 15 years on the board of the West Virginia Educational Broadcasting Authority. She also acted as chairman and founder of Mountain Artisans (a quilting business for low-income artisans), served as a member of the board of directors of the Sunrise Museum and was a teacher's assistant for the Head Start program in Coal Branch Heights.

She is married to Senator John D. "Jay" Rockefeller IV of West Virginia. They have four children.
