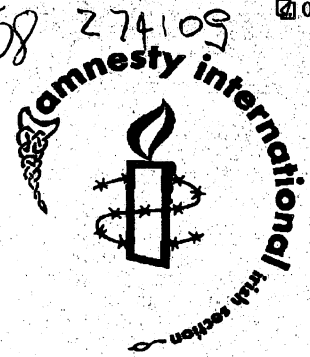

Dear President Bush

On behalf of the Irish Section of Amnesty International I am writing to you in relation to your meeting today with Prime Minister Tony Blair at Camp David where it is expected you will discuss the timing of military intervention in Iraq.

While Amnesty International does not take a position on military action we believe that every state has the obligation to protect civilians under the basic principles of international humanitarian law.

We call on you and Prime Minister Blair to acknowledge the responsibility of the international community for the human rights of the Iraqi people which are in danger of being further violated in the event of a military action.

We urge you and Mr Blair to ensure that the human rights of the Iraqi people are at the forefront of any discussion on Iraq, to carefully consider the impact of military action on the human rights of Iraqi people and to take all measures to prevent a humanitarian disaster.

I would further urge you and Mr Blair to specify what contingency plans are in place for the humanitarian consequences of any military action.

And finally we also call on you and Prime Minister Blair to clarify your stance on bringing Iraqi officials responsible for grave human rights violations to justice.
