

# Kremlin says Yukos investigation is 'harmful' for economy

Russian president Vladimir Putin did not initiate the attack on Yukos, the country's flagship oil company, and considers the action by the prosecutor-general's office harmful for the country's image and economy, a senior Russian official said yesterday.

The official said Mr Putin was not consulted about the attack, although analysts said an action of this size was impossible without the president's knowledge. He said Mr Putin, who had publicly tried not to take sides in the conflict, was taking steps to resolve the action.

"The president cannot simply tell prosecutors to stop investigating a suspected crime," he said. "But he had sent all the necessary signals... that their actions are hurting the political and economic situation in the country."

The official's comments are the first indication of the Kremlin's position in a murky conflict that has shaken the market and Russia's political elite.

"This is a difficult and regrettable situation and the task is to get out of it as quickly as possible, although the damage [to the country's economy] has already been done," he said.

His comments follow a similar call by Mikhail Kasyanov, Russia's prime minister, who last week said protracted investigations into Yukos were hurting the investment climate. His comments provoked a warning from the prosecutor's office to mind his own business.

 The attack on Yukos has alarmed foreign investors and raised questions about property rights in the country. The official said BP, which is in the process of finalising a \$6.75bn deal with TNK, another Russian oil company, was worried about the situation over Yukos and the safety of its investment.

The official said Mr Putin's policy was to prevent any revision of the privatisation results while moving away from the flawed business practices of the 1990s.

ness practices of the 1990s.
"This action [against Yukos] contradicts everything Mr Putin has been trying to achieve, including raising Russia's prestige abroad," the official said.

Over the past month Yukos has been subject to several high profile investigations and police raids. The company's top shareholder remains in detention on charges of theft of state property in a case related to a privatisation deal in 1994. Prosecutors have said they were also investigating five murder and attempted assassination attempts related to the company.

"When a company is accused of murder, theft, violence and tax evasion—all at the same time—it is clearly part of an organised campaign," the official said. However, he did not say who were the powers behind the campaign.

He denied there was any political confrontation between Yukos and the Kremlin and claimed that the attack had nothing to do with the political activities of Mikhail Khodorkovsky, the chief of the company and Russia's wealthiest man, and his lobbying power in the Duma, the lower house of Russian parliament.


