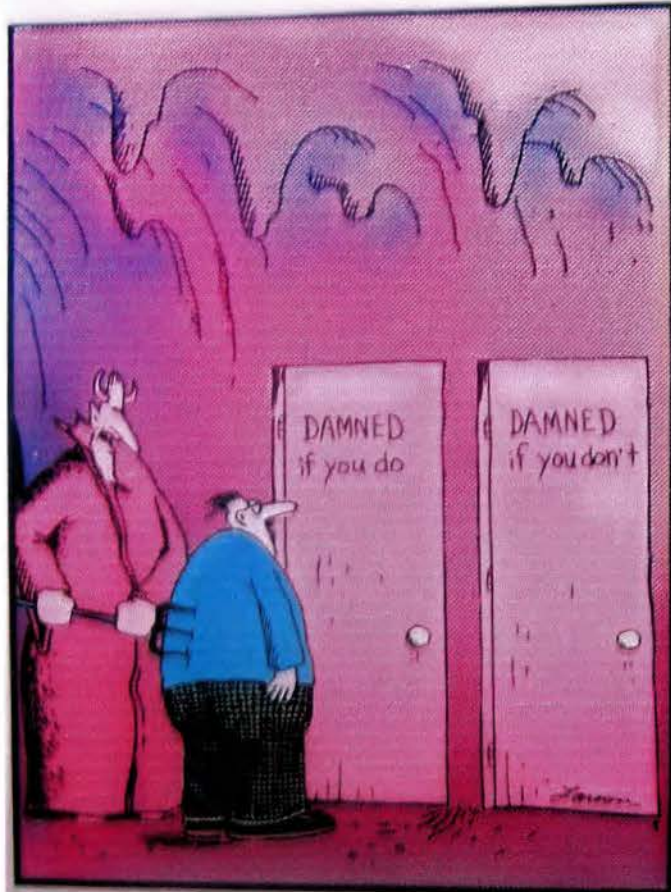

A Note From His Former Pastor In Austin

Dear President Bush,

In unpacking the things I brought home from my office at the church, I ran across the enclosed cartoon a pastor had been given me while I was serving as the Superintendent of the Austin District. I framed it and placed in on my bookshelf because it expressed what was so often the case regarding decisions I had to make regarding pastors and congregations.

As I unpacked it, I thought of you and the options you have. Its painfully humorous message seems especially fitting as you deal with the quagmire in Iraq, the frustrations in Afghanistan, the dangerous obstinacy of North Korea, Iran and Syria, the challenge of working with European allies, the less than honorable behavior of some in your party and the ineptness of the way congressional leaders have handled the mess.

I continue to pray for God to give you wisdom and patience as you lead our nation through these trying times. I am reminded of Thornton Wilder's painfully humorous play produced in the 1940's dealing with the tragic comedy of the human race century after century muddling through by "The Skin Of Our Teeth."
